#### **Brief Introduction to BRICS International Conference**

BRICS International Conference under the framework of the "Wanshou Forum" is one of the efforts jointly made by the China Council for BRICS Think Tank Cooperation (CCBTC) and the University of International Business and Economics, to implement the consensus reached in the 2017 BRICS Summit in Xiamen, to create more opportunities for BRICS academic exchanges and foster cooperation on BRICS issues. It will focus on how to deepen the BRICS partnership to promote a new type of international development. The details of the conference are as follows:

#### **Conference Theme**

Stronger BRICS Partnership for New International Development

#### **Conference Topics**

The conference revolves on the following four topics:

# 1. New International Development and Building a Community of Shared Future for Mankind

In January 2017, President Xi Jinping put forth the concept of building a community of shared future for mankind at the UN headquarters in Geneva, which was later written into the UN and the Security Council resolutions. It rejects the old-school zero-sum game and pursues a new concept featuring common, comprehensive, inclusive, cooperative and sustainable development. This conference will discuss in depth how it contributes to shaping new vision for international development.

#### 2. Exploring New Mechanism and New Path of BRICS Cooperation

The BRICS, the BRICS New Development Bank, and other BRICS mechanisms have increasingly become the most important platforms of cooperation for developing countries. Facing severe challenges in the global governance system, the rising of trade protectionism and populism, the innovation of BRICS cooperation mechanism provides new possibilities for the birth of new economic growth models and renovation of the global governance system. This conference intends to explore the

new mechanism and new path of the BRICS cooperation and ways to contribute to

world peace and development with "BRICS Plan".

3. BRICS Cooperation and Sustainable International Development

How BRICS cooperation promotes international sustainable development is another

important topic of this conference. As the BRICS countries have been among the

fastest-growing economies in the world, the cooperation among BRICS countries is of

model significance for international sustainable development and the realization of the

United Nations 2030 Agenda for sustainable development; At the same time, the

BRICS member countries are still plagued by problems of uneven development and

poverty. The BRICS cooperation itself is a huge contribution to international

development.

4. International Development and Cooperation: Best Practices from BRICS

Scholars, government officials and entrepreneurs from BRICS countries will share

successful cases of international development and cooperation, analyze the impetuses

and obstacles, and promote international inclusive development and common

development.


